Community partners, Like The Bruce Museum and The Aldrich Museum of Contemporary Art, provide enrichment activities. Springboard Collaborative offers our students intense literature support delivered by trained teachers and volunteers.

Our B1C staff provide assessments to these after-school students in order to identify needs for additional academic or behavioral support. Our partners at Jewish Family Services of Greenwich offer on-site behavioral and mental health counseling to eligible students.
